




#### Reportable Incidents

- Exposure
- Inadvertant
  - Possession
  - Production
  - Release
- Missing or stolen agent
- Changes affecting containment

## PHAC Incident report



| Incident<br>reported<br>July 23rd,<br>2018       | Two BSOs with different opinions<br>Transparency was best - report is a documentation of<br>the event for future complaints |
|--|---|
| Reported<br>as a<br>suspected<br>exposure        | Reporting options were limited<br>In a building housing 80+ labs, who do you identify as<br>an exposed person               |
| Follow-up<br>reported<br>August<br>16th,<br>2018 | Interviews with personel<br>Consultations with equipment specialists  |

#### Lessons learned

- EOC was unaware of the Regulatory Agency reporting requirements for hazardous materials - BSO & RSO approached EOC with the requirement on return from the week-end.
  - Add an item to the EOC communication checklist to notify BSO & RSO of any incidents in laboratory buildings
- Everyones threshold for reporting is different
